

Outdoor kit and Equipment for Braeside 2024

We will go through this in September but we thought that it might be useful to have over the summer holiday so that you can be prepared in advance. Please name everything.

- 4 or 5 changes of clothing-lightweight 'trousers and T shirts
- 2X Warm fleece/ jumper/hoodie
- Watershoes or old trainers TO GET WET plus EXTRA towel for canoeing
- Waterproof coats (AT LEAST 2 INCASE ONE GETS WET)
- Comfortable walking boots or shoes (CHILDREN WILL NEED 3 PAIRS OF FOOTWEAR - One for getting wet, one general trainers for around the grounds and one for walking etc in)
- Gloves, scarf and warm hat
- Slippers or flip flops- basically a pair of indoor shoes- These MUST be worn inside the house
- Underwear
- Pyjamas- onesie or dressing gown
- Washbag- soap, shampoo, toothbrush, hairbrush/comb
- A small rucksack big enough for LUNCHBOX waterproof and drinks bottle
- A large plastic bag/bin liner to take home damp/dirty clothes
- Torch
- Lunch box/bag
- Water bottle
- Pen, pencil and rubber

Books/magazines

Teddies

Small amount of pocket money (£5 or less in a NAMED envelope) There is a Braeside shop for souvenirs

Cheap camera

Watch is a good idea

OPTIONAL: ONE SMALL packet of sweets

The following items are NOT permitted

MOBILE PHONES

MP3 players/ipods/ tablets

PSP/Nintendo DS

Expensive camera

All kit needs to be in a case or ruck sack that can be carried easily - a wheeled case is excellent (but not essential)
