Our English work during this topic will be based on the rhyming pirate books by Jonny Duddle. We will start by studying The Pirate Cruncher and then read and explore the story Pirates Love Underpants. We will be focusing on using adjectives to describe and narrative structure.

Science

Animals Including Humans - grouping and sorting animals, animal diets, human body and the senses.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be focusing on Place Value within 20 and Addition and Subtraction within 20. There will be a strong focus on number bonds to 20.

PE

In PE this term, we will be focusing on Gymnastics - using equipment to demonstrate different shapes, balances and jumps. We will also be learning how to play Invasion Games.

Music

Geography

In Geography we will be focusing on the question 'Why were maps so important to pirates?' We will be developing our map skills, learning how to ask geographical questions, using aerial images and naming and locating the world's continents and oceans.

Art

In Art, we will be using Eileen Downes for inspiration to create collages based on Ocean Animals. The children will explore collage techniques, different materials and how to layer materials to create texture.
