

English:

Reading:

Our class text for the Spring 2 Term will continue to be 'The Explorer' by Catherine Rundell. Children will continue to secure their ability to read fluently, using punctuation to help with pace and how emphasis changes the meaning of words and sentences.

Writing:

During the Spring 2 term, we will be writing creating stories as part of our Word Book Day writing competition as well as writing our own dragon capture story.

Spelling:

Spelling lessons will take place 4-5 times a week and will build a knowledge of different spelling patterns. They will bring home a list of words at the start of each unit to learn and help them further explore the rules we are learning about.

Science:

There science for this term is 'Sound'. The children will be learning how sounds are made from vibrations. That sound travels in waves and that volume is used to describe the strength of sound. They will conduct a range of investigations and experiments to test ideas and further their understanding.

Art/DT/Music:

Our DT this terms will be 'Structures'. We will be learning to understand how structures support themselves and how to use a range of tools in construction.

In music children will learn about different musical styles (Hip-hop, classical, pop) through the listen, appraise and perform.

Maths:

Children should now know all of their times tables from 2-12. They should now be working on being about to use all of these randomly.

We will cover topics on Fractions and Decimals. Children need to compare, order, add and subtract fractions and mixed numbers. They also need to be able to work in tenths and hundredths when multiplying and dividing by 10,100 and 1000.

History/Geography:

Our Spring 2 History work will be learning about Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings.
